WHERE IS NORDKAPP?

- Located at the northernmost point of mainland Europe, on Magerøya island
- A remote yet accessible Arctic destination known for spectacular landscapes and rich cultural heritage

FISHING VILLAGES AND LOCAL LIFE

- Honningsvåg – The city by the North Cape, gateway to Nordkapp
- Gjesvær – Famous for Gjesværstappan Nature Reserve, a paradise for birdwatchers
- Skarsvåg – One of the world's northernmost fishing villages, close to Kirkeporten rock formation
- Kamøyvær – A small fishing village with a local art gallery
- Nordvågen – A traditional fishing hub with breathtaking Arctic scenery

HOW TO GET HERE?

- By Air: Flights to Honningsvåg Airport (HVG) via Tromsø or Alta
- By Road: E69 scenic drive from mainland Norway, accessible via the Nordkapp Tunnel
- By Sea: Cruise ships and Hurtigruten and Havila stop in Honningsvåg

- Arctic Light Season (Feb–Apr) – Sun returns, snowy adventures, low golden light



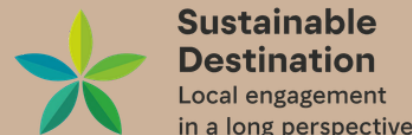

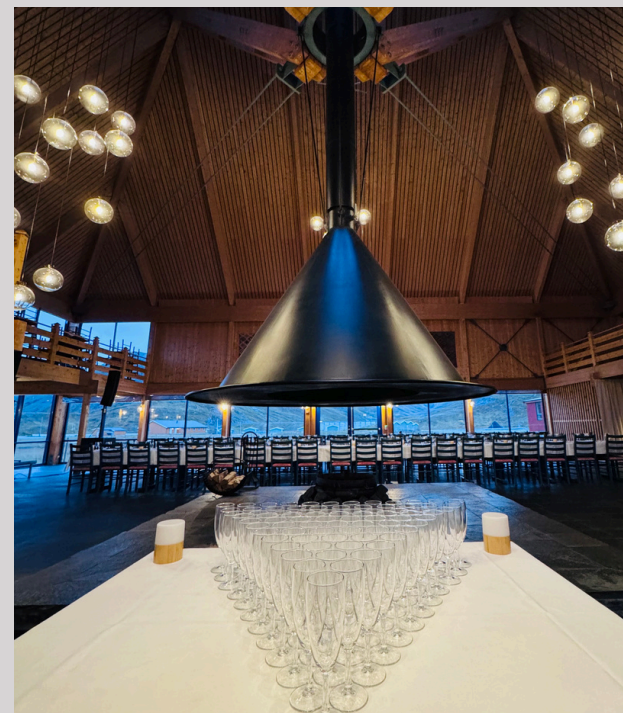
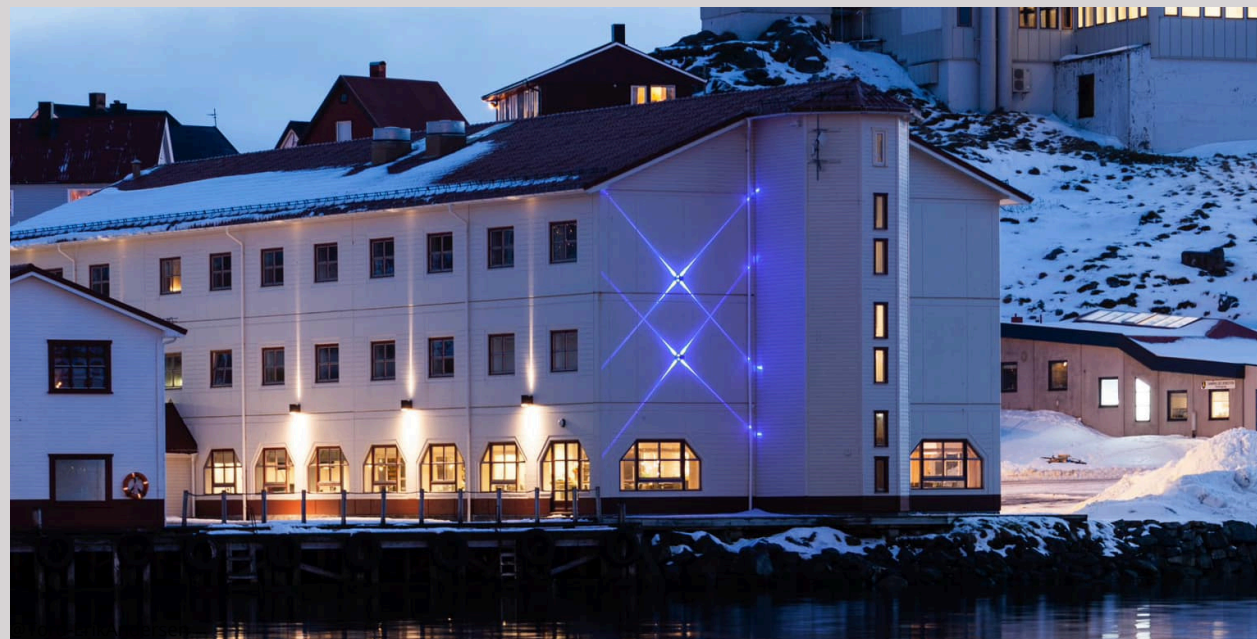

THE NORTH CAPE HALL

ABOUT

- A historic visitor center built into the cliff at the North Cape Plateau
- Offers panoramic film, historical exhibitions, an exclusive Gift Shop and a Coffee House all year round.
- Restaurant with breathtaking views over the Barents Sea (open during the summer season, and upon request outside the main season)
- During the summer season, guests can also visit the Post Office and Panorama Bar. The official North Cape postmark is available year-round when sending postcards from the North Cape Hall.

HISTORY AND ATTRACTIONS

- Built in 1959, expanded in 1988 and 1997 to accommodate thousands of visitors
- The Globe Monument – Iconic symbol marking the northernmost point of Europe
- Children of the Earth Monument – Artwork created by children from different nations, symbolizing unity and hope

- Spectacular panoramic film showcasing the four seasons in the Arctic landscape

- A premier wildlife safari operator offering daily boat tours to Gjesværstappan Nature Reserve
- Based in Gjesvær fishing village, 36 km from Honningsvåg
- Expert-guided tours showcasing one of Norway's largest seabird colonies

- Operating season: May 1 – September 1

BIRD SAFARI TO GJESVÆRSTAPPAN

- A two-hour boat tour departing from Gjesvær to Gjesværstappan Nature Reserve, 15 km west of Nordkapp
- 10-minute boat ride from the pier to the nature reserve
- Onboard amenities: Arctic suits for warmth, coffee, biscuits, souvenirs, and restrooms
- Up-close wildlife encounters with:
 - Puffins – Easily recognizable by their colorful beaks, nesting in grassy hills
 - Kittiwakes, Guillemots, Razorbills, Cormorants, Arctic Skuas, Fulmars, and Gannets
- Ethical wildlife experience – Visitors observe the birds from the boat as stepping onto the islands is not allowed
- Guides & crew available to answer questions throughout the journey
