Air

Bodø Airport is conveniently located just 2 km from the city centre, serving as a vital hub for the Salten region and Nordland County.

Car

There are two main routes to reach Bodø & Salten by car: the E6 (via Fv80) and the scenic Coastal Route (Fv17). Nordland is also home to three official Norwegian Scenic Routes.

Hurtigruten/Havila

Has 10 ports of call in Nordland. Daily departures and arrivals all year round.

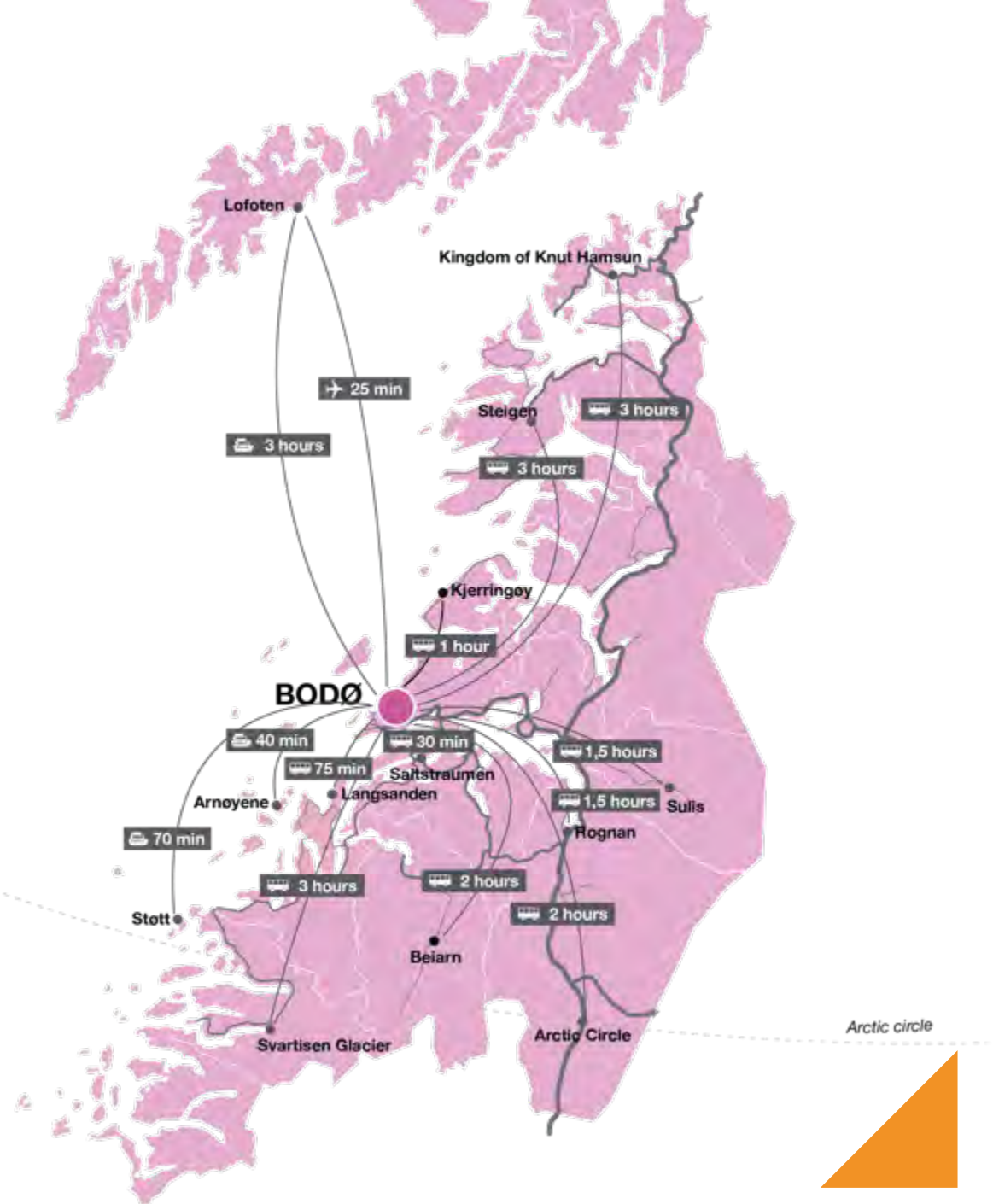
Train

Bodø is the terminus of the railway line from Oslo and Trondheim, with several daily departures on local and regional southbound trains.

Express boat/Ferry/Bus

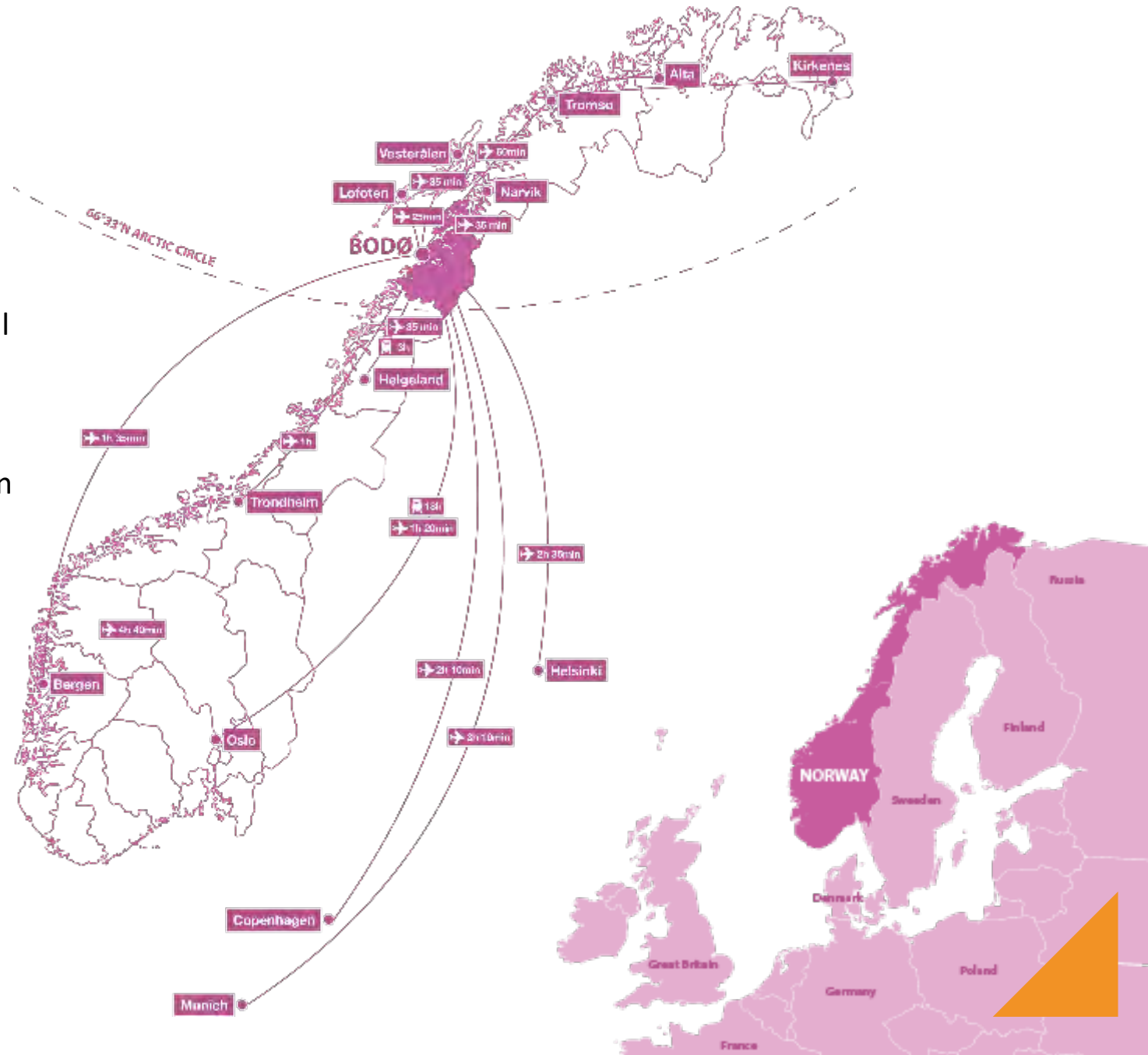

How to get here

Bodø, located just above the Arctic Circle, plays a vital role as a hub for the wider Nordland region—connecting and providing access to the surrounding areas. Its strategic location places it near the polar region and establishes it as a key gateway to Northern Norway. The city also serves as an ideal base for experiencing natural wonders such as the Midnight Sun and the Northern Lights.





Scandinavian Airlines Stockholm-Bodø

Stockholm - Bodø 2026

- Operates from 5 June to 14 September
- Shoulder season: flights on Mondays and Fridays
- Peak season: additional flight on Wednesdays – total 3 flights/week



Scandinavian Airlines København-Bodø

Copenhagen - Bodø 2026

- Starts 29 March and runs until 24 October
- Operates weekly on Mondays, Thursdays, and Sundays
- During peak summer (20 June – 9 August): additional flights on Tuesdays and Thursdays
