How to get here

By plane:

- Tromsø, the main airport used to reach our region
 - Many new direct flights from cities in Europe
- Sørkjosen, the local airport operated by Widerøe
- (Alta)
- (Bardufoss)

Hurtigruten/Havila:

- Port of Skjervøy

Train/Bus:

- Narvik and bus from there
- Arctic route bus from Tromsø /Finland
- Good public bus transportation

Distances:

- Narvik - Lyngen: 200 km, 3h
- Alta - Lyngen: 230 km, 4.5h
- Tromsø - Lyngen: 2h
- Kilpisjärvi (FI) - Lyngen: 45min
- Kiruna - Lyngen: 350 km, 4h

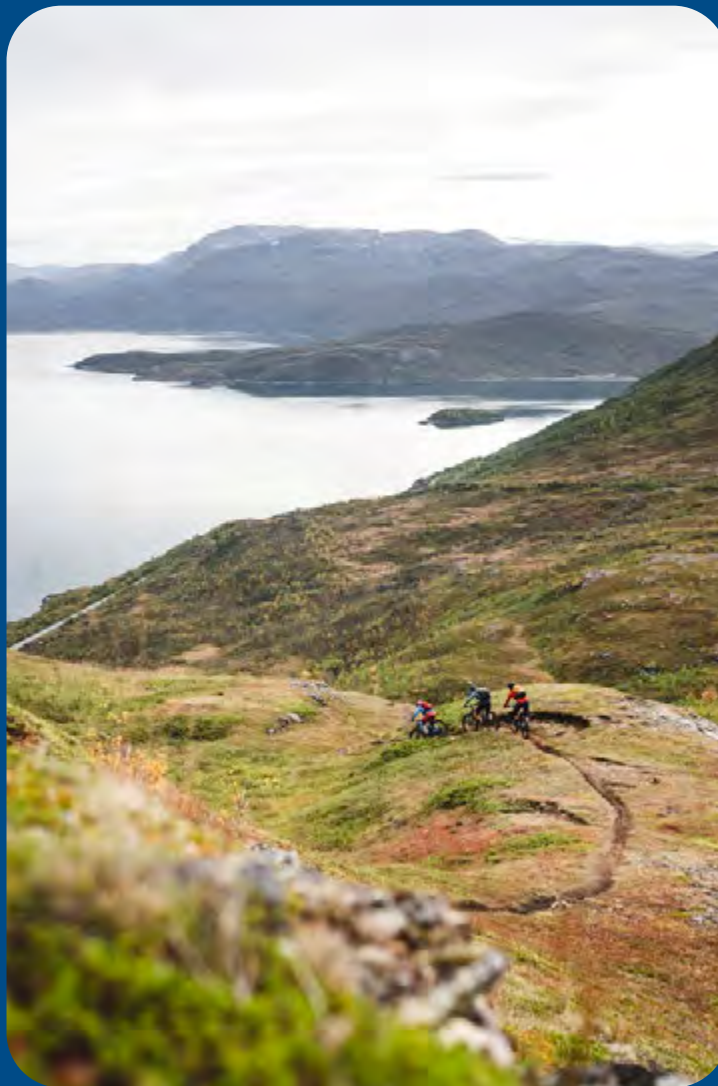

Our Seasons

- Spring time (March - May)
 - End of the Northern Lights and start ski touring
- Summer (June - August)
 - Midnightsun: 20th May - 22 July
- Autumn (August - October)
 - First northern lights late august/early september
 - Whales arrive late Oct
- Winter (Dec - March)
 - first snow can often be seen on the mountain peaks late October

Group sizes for activities:

First northern lights appear mid-august/early september

The whales arrive outside Skjervøy late October

First snow on the mountain peaks late october
